### **Update – mid-May 2018**

Following completion of the Project Team's formal public consultation all the feedback has been analysed; several amendments have been made to the proposal and the supporting documents as a result. The documents – all of which you can view [HERE](#) – have now been submitted to Wiltshire Council who can now conduct their own public consultation.

Once the Council's consultation is complete the proposal will be forwarded to an independent examiner to begin the next stage. The examiner will be a planning specialist tasked to examine the proposal in detail and ensure that all the relevant legislation, regulations and procedures have been complied with. Once he is satisfied, the proposal will be returned to Wiltshire Council with a recommendation that the matter proceed to a referendum.

The referendum will be managed by Wiltshire Council and it will follow the same pattern as a local council or parliamentary election with polling notification being sent to everyone eligible to vote; this is everyone aged 18 and over who is resident in the [Designated Neighbourhood Area](#).

It's very difficult to predict timescales as the process is not under our control and as the procedure hasn't been used in Wiltshire before there is no previous experience to guide us.
